Buddies

Every child has now been linked with at least one buddy. I spoke to some children who were very excited about this new initiative. The purpose is to promote positive behaviour by encouraging the older buddies to act as positive role models to their young buddies. Buddies will have opportunities to meet each other both informally and during lesson time.

Houses

We reviewed the 'House' system with the aim of re-launching it this year. When I spoke to the children I realised that they did not really know much about the previous patron saints. As part of this process my colleagues and I also considered other options to engage the children. You will recall that I also wrote to you for ideas and feedback. I would like to thank those of you able to respond and your suggestions were included as part of this process. After careful consideration we decided to renew the system and select the UK's national Saints to be patrons of our School Houses. All staff, apart from Mrs Evans and I will also be members of each House. On a feast day the members of the house only, children and staff, will be invited to attend school in their House colour rather than wear normal school uniform. If the feast day is on a weekend or during a holiday the children will be allowed to dress up on the day highlighted on the table below:
