

This week we will continue to focus on traditional tales.


Our Story of the Week


Our Song of the Week



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


Ideas to try at home:

- Songs this week are to help your child with our activities on subtraction – to show that when we **take away** we have **less than** the amount that we had before
- Please join in with the songs and use objects at home such as small toys, socks, etc. and practise counting up to 10 and then then taking away – one or two at a time – what amount is left?
