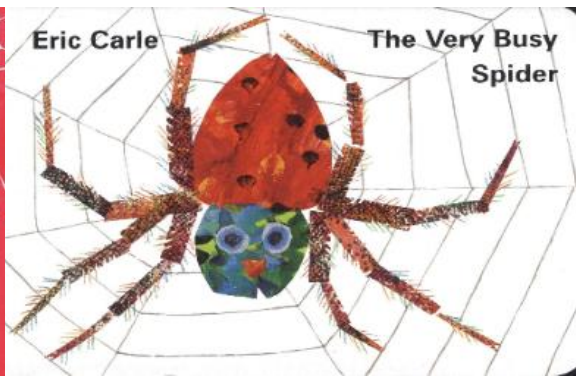
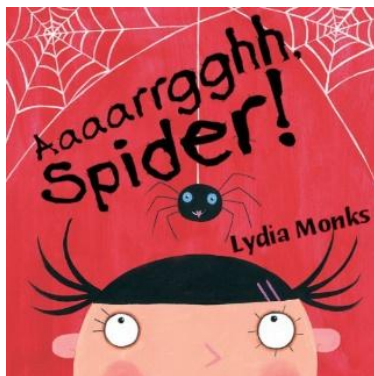




FS2 MOUSE CLUB

They will also develop an understanding of how to treat minibeasts with care and the importance of protecting their habitats and the environment.

We are going to learn the Makaton actions that go with the song, please click [here](#) to have a go.

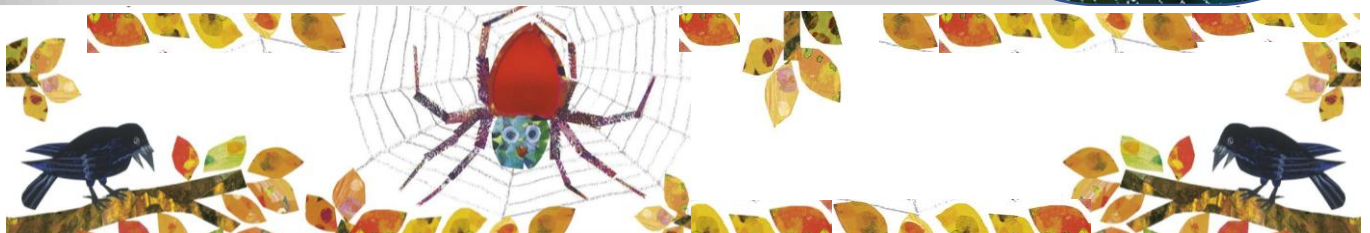
Incy Wincy Spider

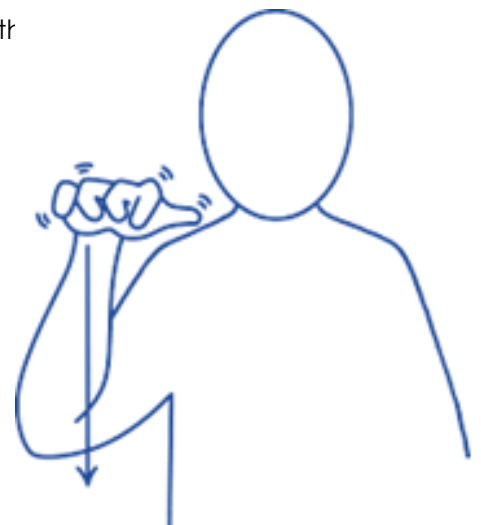
