Throughout December the children will reflect on 'patience' in their weekly Virtues class assemblies.











Lyceum Pantomime 2025

We will be visiting the Lyceum Theatre, Sheffield, on **Wednesday 10th December 2025** to watch this year's panto, *Aladdin*. On the day, children must wear <u>full</u> school uniform.

Timings:

We will leave school at 12.00pm to arrive in good time for the 1.00pm start. The show will last approximately two and a half hours. Children will have an early packed lunch before we leave. We expect to return to school around 4:30pm, though this may vary depending on the performance length, leaving the theatre, and evening traffic. To avoid delays, we ask that children be collected at 5:00pm.

Collection Arrangements:

- Gates will open at 4.45pm, please wait on the playground.
- Entry via the parish car park and exit via the usual pedestrian school gates.
- Staff will be stationed at all gates to ensure children do not leave our site unaccompanied.
- For safety reasons wait in school do <u>not</u> surround returning coaches or wait on the pavement by school.
- Children will first collect their belongings from classrooms before being released (as they usually are).
- FS2 children will be dismissed from the library exit (next to the YS2 door) on to the playground.
- As it will be dark, please answer clearly when your child's name is called.
- If we are later than 5.00pm, a text will be sent (so please ensure we have your up-to-date contact details)


