

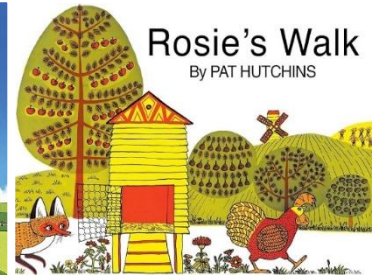
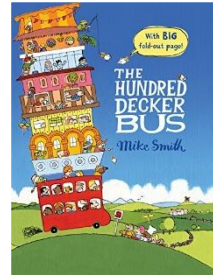


FS2 MOUSE CLUB

We will also investigate the different forms of transport that can be used for journeys and consider some of the reasons people have for travelling, including going to school, work and shopping.

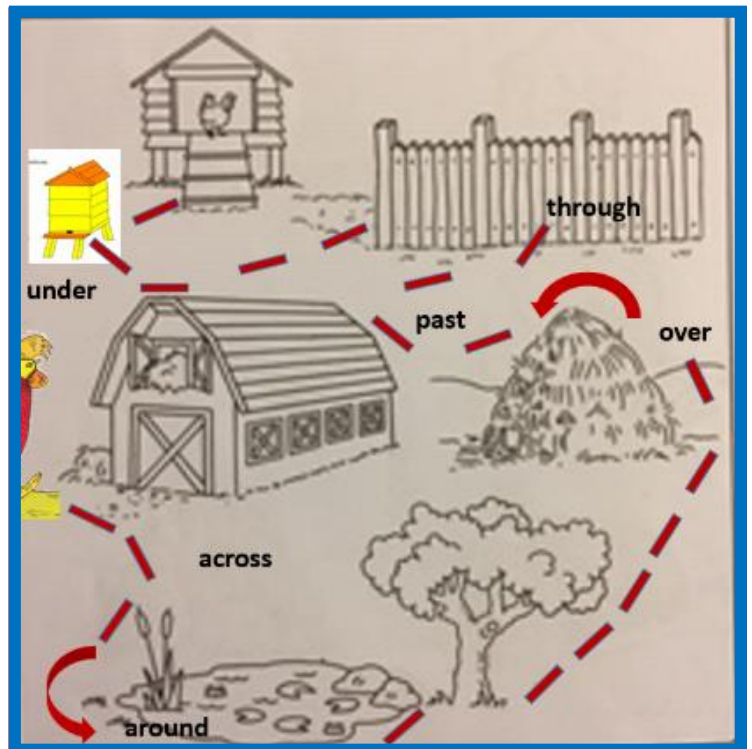
Our song of the week

Activities to Try at Home

- Please look out for **prepositions** in the story and think about how they are used, for example, **across**, **around**, **over** and **behind**.
- Encourage your child to use the words when you ask them to remember where, exactly, Rosie was going when she went '**around**' or '**under**' etc.
- Ask your child to hide their mouse and then give you clues to find it, e.g. look '**behind**' the chair, '**in between**' the cushions, or **next to** the plant, etc.
- Look at the patterns in the story illustrations. Have a go at creating your own repeating patterns.
- With a grown-up have a go at drawing your own map of the farm that Rosie walks around.

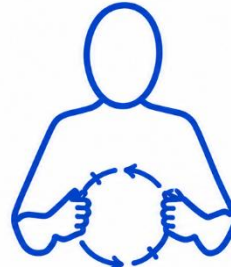
