Here comes the Winter with the nights getting longer.



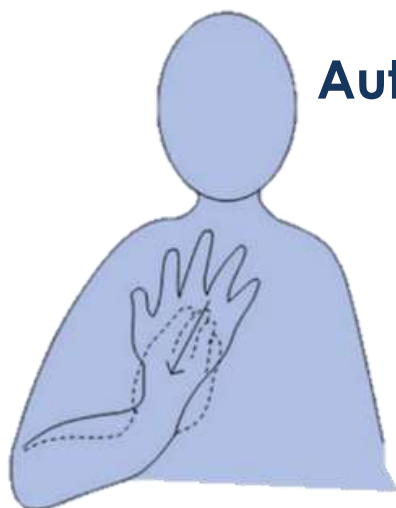
Ideas to try at home

Our Makaton actions this week are Autumn, Summer, Spring and Winter.



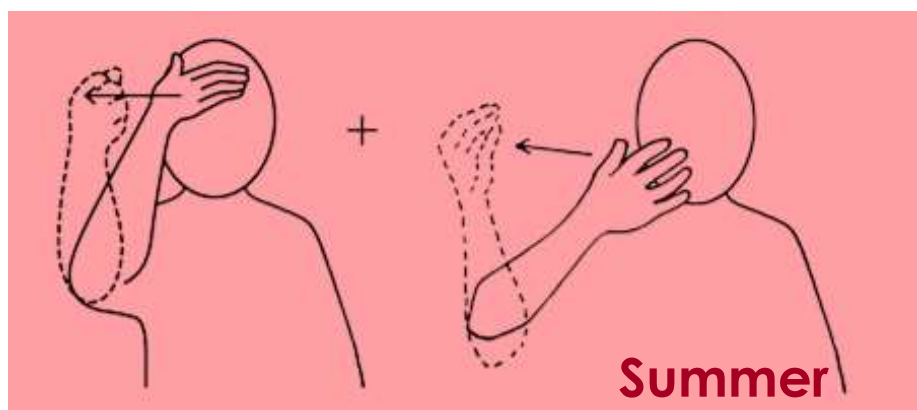
