


Things to try at home

- Listen out for rhyming words (remind your child that these words have the same sound at the end of the word, for example, funny and tummy, bored and sword).
- Can you find your own words that rhyme with the following words? **shark, sea, fish, shell, rock, boat, sand and wave.**
- Play I Spy with the illustrations - e.g. I Spy an animal beginning with 'o' (please use the letter **sound** – o for octopus) or play I Spy using description, e.g., 'an animal with a flat body, it looks like it has wings...'
- We have been learning how to break words apart into syllables – can they clap and count the number of syllables in the names of the different creatures? E.g., crab – one syllable, dolphin – two syllables, octopus – 3 syllables.

Flat hand moves under top hand.




Slightly bent hand slots between thumb and fingers of other hand.
